A one way system to be implemented with ENTRANCE at the Trafalgar Square door and EXIT from the double doors in the hall into Market Street, with necessary signage.

The Hirer to be responsible for the following implementations:

Good Ventilation allowed with double doors remaining open and/or windows open. A maximum number of 30 people to be allowed entry into the Town Hall at any one time. This number to include organisers.

Seating to be placed 2 chairs apart

'Track and Trace' programme by the hirer.

Once these precautions are in place, THQ ctte to review if we can then open.
