New Road Hill/Lostwithiel Street/Hanson Drive Junction

Fowey Town Council would appreciate your views regarding the work undertaken at the junction of New Road Hill/ Hanson Drive/Lostwithiel Street in November 2023. The following works were carried out.

- Improving a pedestrian crossing point on Hanson Drive. Adjusting kerbs, installing tactile paving and coloured high friction surfacing.
- Resurfacing the junction of Lostwithiel Street with Hanson Drive and installation of 'imprint' surfacing
- General re-surfacing of the road
- Widening the footway on Lostwithiel Street to 1.8m and installing new granite kerbs
- Creating a level resting place with a bench
- Resurfacing the footway between Hanson Drive and Lostwithiel Street
- Amending and repainting of the road markings
